Kids Classes (5-13yrs)

A variety of fun, exciting skills-based courses for children 5 to 13 years with a max of 8-10 students to ensure individual attention.

Drawing/Painting (5-8yrs)

Monday 3.45-5.15pm 9 week term

An exciting course offering a range of learning experiences and concepts to spark the imagination and creativity of young children. Gain confidence through sharing ideas, experimenting with a variety of mediums and learning basic skills. Children will learn drawing techniques and paint in a range of mediums. Pottery/sculpture also included in this course. **Tutor:** Ochre Lawson

Drawing/Painting (8-12yrs)

Tuesday 3.45-5.30pm 9 week term

An excellent structured program designed specifically for students wishing to learn the basic skills of art-making and build upon them. Children gain confidence in their ability to draw realistically and creatively and experience a range of visual arts including drawing, acrylics, watercolour, pastels, printmaking, pottery, sculpture, design and mixed-media. **Tutor:** Judy Voltz

Cartooning/Animation (9-13yrs)

Tuesday 4-6pm 8 week term

Learn to create exciting cartoon characters, action cartooning and caricatures. Explore the art of animation with a pencil, paper and camera. Traditional techniques will be taught in this class. Max student number is 8. **Tutor:** Ivan Olea

Drawing/Painting/Pottery/Printmaking (5-12yrs)

Wednesday 3.45-5.30pm 9 week term

A fun course for young students to learn drawing techniques and paint in a range of mediums including watercolour, acrylics and pastels. Pottery, sculpture, textiles and printmaking also included. **Tutor:** Jane King

Junior Certificate (9-13yrs)

Thursday 4.15-6.15pm 2x8 week terms

A structured program designed for students wishing to learn the basic skills of art-making and build upon them. Children will gain confidence in their ability to draw realistically and creatively and experience a range of visual arts areas including drawing, acrylic painting, watercolour, pastels, printmaking, sculpture, design and mixed-media. Create a portfolio over 2 terms and receive a certificate on completion. Students can then follow on to our senior certificate course. Taught by specialist teachers.

Artmaking -Drawing and Painting (7-12yrs)

Saturday 10-12 noon 9 week term

The Art of Animation

Tuesday 6.15-8.15pm 8 week term

Students learn to animate with a pencil, paper and a camera. Learn traditional animation skills, the foundation to good animation. Advanced techniques taught (beginners to advanced students welcome) max 8 students. **Tutor:** Ivan Olea

Senior Certificate

Wednesday 4.15-6.15pm 2x8 week terms

Our unique 16 week Senior Certificate is for students to improve their drawing and painting skills and learn basic colour, and design fundamentals. Mediums covered include acrylics, watercolour, pastels, mixed-media and printmaking. Graduate with a comprehensive portfolio of artwork. Students can then go on to complete an advanced certificate specializing in various mediums. Students will be taught by specialist teachers in the various mediums.

Clay Pottery/Sculpture

Thursday 4-6pm 8 week term

Students explore the tactile qualities of clay and handbuilding techniques - develop your ideas into actual artworks. Learn a variety of surface treatments, underglazes, glazes and kiln firing. Subjects include both traditional and contemporary pottery and large scale sculptures of animals and portraits. **Tutor:** Jane King

Drawing and Painting

Saturday 10am-12noon 9 week term
